

**ADDENDUM TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS SUPPORT FUND  
RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM  
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-13  
(REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NUMBER 2012-09)**

Due to extensive statewide closures resulting from Hurricane Isaac, the deadline for submission of notices of intent to the Research Competitiveness Subprogram (RCS) and Industrial Ties Research Subprogram (ITRS) has been changed from Tuesday, September 11, 2012 at 4:30 p.m. central to Friday, September 14, 2012 at 4:30 p.m. central. **Section IV. Procedure and Deadline for Submission of Notices of Intent**

Before a full proposal will be accepted, the applicant must first submit a completed notice of intent form for each research proposal to be submitted. The notice of intent must be submitted via LOGAN to the Board of Regents by 4:30 p.m., September 14, 2012. One of the primary purposes of the notice of intent is to assist the Support Fund R & D Program staff in identifying potential reviewers. Failure to provide the required information on potential reviewers as described in the instructions in LOGAN, including telephone numbers and email addresses, may result in disqualification of the notice of intent. In this event, the full proposal for which the notice of intent was filed will not be accepted.
