#### INTRODUCTION

A review panel consisting of Dr. Gregory Blakey, University of Central Arkansas, chair; Ms. Virginia Rougon Chavis, University of Mississippi; and Dr. Robert Thompson, Georgia State University, communicated via e-mail and phone in March 2016, for the purpose of evaluating twenty-four (24) Arts proposals submitted to the Louisiana Board of Regents through the Traditional Enhancement component of the Board of Regents Support Fund.

The review panel received the following materials prior to their review: twenty-four (24) Arts proposals to be evaluated, with appropriately numbered rating forms; b) a summary of proposals listing titles, principal investigators, institutions, dollars requested, etc.; c) the FY 2015-16 Traditional and Undergraduate Enhancement Request for Proposals; and d) a copy of the 2012-13 Traditional Enhancement Final Report in Arts.

Prior to the review, each panel member independently evaluated and annotated each of the twenty-four proposals. During the review process, all proposals were fully discussed by the reviewers. In each case unanimous agreement was reached, and the reviewers ensured that the proposal received a thorough and fair evaluation based on criteria enumerated in the RFP.

Table I contains a rank-order list of the proposals highly recommended for funding with recommended funding levels. Proposals recommended for funding if additional monies become available are listed in Table II. Proposals not recommended for funding are listed in Table III. A detailed review of each proposal follows immediately after the tables. Due to fiscal exigencies and the need to fund only those projects assured of success, the panel did not recommend any projects with scores of 86 or lower. A summary of all proposals submitted (Appendix A) and a copy of the rating forms used in the evaluations (Appendix B) are attached at the end of the report.

This proposal seeks to a equip a 3D-design lab with a 3D printer, computers, software and related accessories. The timeline provided does not give dates, so it is not clear how the project will realistically fit within the academic calendar. The proposal states workshops are planned for November, which seems early for a studio that has yet to be built. It is noted that the program is SACS accredited, but it is not clear if it has been accredited by the National Association of Schools of Art and Design as well. It appears that there are currently no intermediate or advanced courses in 3D design. The proposal states that there is a rapid national rise in students enrolling in 3D courses, but there is actually a national decline in visual arts enrollment. The computers can be acquired for much less than the prices listed. It is not clear why the additional keyboards and accessories are necessary. It is not evident how the equipment will be maintained or if the space needs infrastructure upgrades to accommodate the equipment. The supplies for the printers are very expensive. The request is high relative to the amount of funds available, especially given the small number of students and faculty impacted. There is no institutional match. Funding is not recommended.

This proposal seeks laptops and related musical accessories to create individual stations for an experimental music ensemble. The objectives are wide ranging and numerous and perhaps should be structured to focus on those directly impacted by the requested technology. The work plan is well constructed. The plan for some equipment to be fabricated with the interaction of students is a positive feature that adds significantly to the academic programs and courses in place. It is not clear if the requested iPhones and Apple watches can only be purchased without a data plan or if the institution has provisions for this. Corporate sponsors for the program are listed but the type and level of support are not described. The description of impact on culture is interesting but the argument for economic impact could be stronger. Partial funding of \$58,000 is recommended if additional funds become available, with reductions made at the discretion of the PI. The institutional match may be reduced proportionately.

The School of Art requests equipment to create a new digital design studio and lab, and renovate an existing studio and lab. The goals are clearly and simply stated. The reuse of existing equipment shows commendable conservation of resources. There is a very clear and articulate plan for successful implementation. The crowning element of the proposal is the number of students served and the role the project will play in the technology transformation of arts education on campus. Outcomes and evaluation are addressed but could use more elaboration. It is not evident how the Adobe Creative Cloud will be funded after the first year. The enhancement of four major spaces represents an ambitious range of activity; a prioritized project could still provide valuable impact. Partial funding of \$75,000 is recommended, with reductions to be made at the discretion of the PI. The institutional match may be reduced proportionately.

The School of Design seeks to modernize classroom instruction with new image making tools. The arguments that the equipment will increase student engagement and attract new students need substantiation. For some equipment choices, the advantages of the requested purchases over the existing resources is not made evident. The proposal states that the University is a regional leader in design education but no supporting details are provided. It is not clear if the affected courses are existing or in development. The listed objectives are not measurable. The work plan cites benchmarks but it is not apparent what is being measured and how. It is not evident what skills the faculty will develop or if they are currently trained on this equipment. Funding is not recommended.

The School of the Performing Arts seeks to upgrade facilities with a theatre console and related equipment. The enhancement is an appropriate step forward and will allow the campus to maintain the current level of instruction via industry-standard equipment. Several separate systems are being enhanced or upgraded and, while all the improvements are desirable, not all of them are vital to stage management. The goals are appropriate but need to be stated in a way that lead to measurable objectives. The equipment will be utilized by a range of stage management courses, but more specific examples of curriculum impact would have improved the proposal. The institutional match is a benefit and demonstrates support. Partial funding of \$70,000 is recommended if additional funds become available, with reductions to be made at the discretion of the PI. The institutional match should be maintained in full.

The School of Design seeks to equip the Digital Incubation Gallery and Research Laboratory, a multipurpose facility that includes an indoor gallery, an outdoor projection theatre and a computer design lab. The project goals are not clearly stated in the appropriate section, though they are articulated better in the evaluation plan. A compelling argument is made for the innovation and uniqueness of the project. A measurable objective aligned with the goal of pursuing partnerships would have benefited the proposal. It is not clear if the requested studio furniture is for specific technical use or just seating. The equipment, overall, is not carefully described. The need for the outdoor space is not justified. The community outreach and the potential for arts collaborations and visiting artists are positive components. The PIs have a good track record and the efforts to create industry connections are impressive. Funding is not recommended.

This proposal seeks a state-of-the-art audio-visual projection system for the major theatre space on campus. The rationale is not compelling and need is not established. Measurable objectives and outcomes such as retention and recruitment are not described. The number of students who would use the projector is not indicated. It is not clearly established what each piece of equipment is for. It is not evident who will be running the equipment and how they will be trained. The project appears to be set up as a large-format smart classroom but the pedagogical impact is not articulated. The proposal is, overall, too brief and lacks details. The additional funding sources are laudable. No funding is recommended.

The School of Design seeks to enhance its photography facilities. Though the goals are clear, they are numerous and repetitive and should be consolidated. A strong argument is made for acquiring industry-standard equipment to prepare students. The curricular impact and educational outcomes are evident. The work plan lacks detail. The evaluation plan is relatively weak. The effort to develop collaborations with industry is compelling. The pledged institutional support is laudable. Partial funding of \$75,000 is recommended if additional funds become available, with reductions to be made at the discretion of the PI. The institutional match may be reduced proportionately.

The Department of Visual Arts seeks to upgrade the ceramics kiln room. Safety is mentioned as a concern but not developed into an argument. More details are necessary to understand what will be measured for each goal. The work plan does not establish if any building upgrades will be necessary to handle the technology. There is clear impact on a reasonably large number of courses, but it is not clear that totally automating the firing process better prepares students in firing practices. Because these expensive kilns run themselves, there is no student involvement. A long list of outcomes is provided with little detail of how they will be evaluated; examples would strengthen this section. A number of the requested costs, such as installation and training, should be covered by the institution. The request is excessive and could be formulated at much lower cost. Funding is not recommended.

The Department of Performing Arts seeks to acquire a high-lumen digital projector with multiple lenses for each performance venue. The rationale argues that upgraded projection will overcome increasing scenic budgets but does not mention the need to teach various scenic techniques. The educational outcomes need to be clearly stated in measurable terms. It is not clear if an LED curtain was considered. The impact on the curriculum is not made evident; it is not clear how this projector will replace current equipment for classroom purposes. Development of cross-curricular aspects of the project are important and need inclusion. A maintenance plan is not clearly established. The PI has experience in technical direction and also production management, though external partnerships are currently limited to one collaborator. Funding is not recommended.

While a more straightforward list would have been helpful, it is clear that the PIs have carefully chosen each item and justified the need. The enhancement will impact a relatively high number of students and faculty across a variety of music media and music business courses. Full funding is recommended.

The Fine Arts Department seeks to build a degree program along with a specialized lab for digital media arts. The main strengths of the request are the collaborative nature of the program and the relative lack of similar regional programs. A strong collaboration already in place on campus between fine arts and computer science is a compelling asset. One flaw is that existing courses slated to help build this degree are listed by number without supporting details. The requested equipment list is straightforward, reasonable and efficient and will be effectively combined with existing supporting equipment. The eleven-station media center for digital animation appears to be appropriate. Cultural and economic impact could be elaborated, especially in light of recent State efforts to develop a film production industry. Full funding is recommended.
