Due to the closure of the Board of Regents for the Veterans Day Holiday, the deadline for submission of proposals to the Consortium for Innovation in Manufacturing and Materials (CIMM) Seed Funding Track 1: Faculty Research Awards Program has been changed from Monday, November 11, 2019 at 4:30 p.m. central to Tuesday, November 12, 2019 at 4:30 p.m. central. It is the intention of the Board of Regents to request a six-month no-cost extension on the parent award from NSF. If awarded, the PI may request an extension until December 31, 2020.

**Proposal Submission**

The proposal must be submitted to the Board of Regents by the submitting institution's authorized representative, no later than the close of business day (4:30 p.m.) on **Tuesday, November 12, 2019**. All online submissions must be uploaded as a **single PDF document** through the LOGAN system. Proposal submission is a two-step process. Following PI submission, the proposal is routed to your employing institution for review, approval, and final submission to the Board of Regents' EPSCoR office; the Board does not receive and will not accept the proposal directly from the PI. Deadlines listed in the RFP are absolute; all approved proposals must be submitted by the campus and received by the Board on or before the published proposal deadline. The proposal submission system will automatically close at 4:30 p.m. Central Standard Time on the deadline date.
