The consultant's final report, including funding recommendations for the five (5) proposals submitted to the Board of Regents/SREB Doctoral Support Initiative to Promote Student and Faculty Diversity, is now posted on the website of the Board of Regents Research and Sponsored Initiatives Section, <https://rsi.laregents.edu/>. Institutions may notify the Board of acceptance of the award in April, as part of the response to all funding recommendations. **As soon as possible following Board action at the April meeting, contracts for approved projects will be transmitted through each campus's institutional LOGAN account. As indicated in program requests for proposals, BoR/SREB contracts funded in this cycle will have an effective date of August 1, 2024.**
