Proposals Due: June 7, 2024

Question:

One of our faculty plans to submit a proposal for the FY 24-25 LAMDA Seed Funding Track 1 B funding opportunity. The FY 24-25 Request for Proposals states that "The PI should not currently be funded by LAMDA." This faculty does have a current LAMDA award that ends August 31, 2024. Is this faculty eligible to apply for the FY 24-25 funding cycle?

Thank you for your question. The faculty is eligible for the Track1B competition. The clause you are referring to is for those faculty who are senior/key personnel and receiving salary support from LAMDA, not seed awardees.

Question:

I'm writing in regard to LAMDA FY 24-25 Request for Proposals (Track 1 B: Collaborative Partnership Award). I have an active Track 1A seed grant that ends this August. Am I eligible to apply for Track 1B this year for the FY 24-25?
